### 2. HAZARDS IDENTIFICATION

Main hazards: No significant hazard.

### 3. COMPOSITION / INFORMATION ON INGREDIENTS

### 4. FIRST AID MEASURES (SYMPTOMS)

Skin contact: There may be mild irritation at the site of contact.  
Eye contact: There may be irritation and redness.

### 4. FIRST AID MEASURES (ACTION)

### 6. ACCIDENTAL RELEASE MEASURES

Personal precautions: Refer to section 8 of SDS for personal protection details. Turn leaking containers leak-side up to prevent the escape of liquid.  
Environmental precautions: Do not discharge into drains or rivers. Contain the spillage using bunding. Warning relates to a large spillage, not a single bottle.  
Clean-up procedures: Absorb into dry earth or sand. Transfer to a closable, labelled salvage container for disposal by an appropriate method. Wash the spillage site with large amounts of water. Single bottle spillage: wash down the drain with a large amount of water.

### 7. HANDLING AND STORAGE

Handling requirements: Avoid direct contact with the substance. Ensure there is sufficient ventilation of the area.
